Latinos LEAD (Latinos for Leadership Excellence And Diversity) is accepting applications from climate and conservation nonprofit organizations seeking to increase the racial and ethnic diversity of their governing boards.

This phase of the Diversity in Environmental Leadership Initiative ([DELI 2.0](#)) will provide free virtual workshops for leadership teams of climate and conservation nonprofit organizations. The "[Inclusion Blueprint](#)" workshops provide specific, measurable, and practical tools for defining inclusion goals and for successfully recruiting and retaining Latino governing board members. Services are limited to ten organizations during this round.

Organizations that successfully complete the Inclusion Blueprint process will be eligible to engage with Latinos LEAD for governing board member [recruiting services](#) at reduced-fee levels (fees vary by organization size and scope, and the number of board members recruited).

### **ELIGIBILITY:**

1. Available only to 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations
2. Demonstrated progress toward a mission devoted to climate and conservation, environmental justice, or related field
3. Based in California or is an active California-based chapter or affiliate of a national nonprofit organization.
